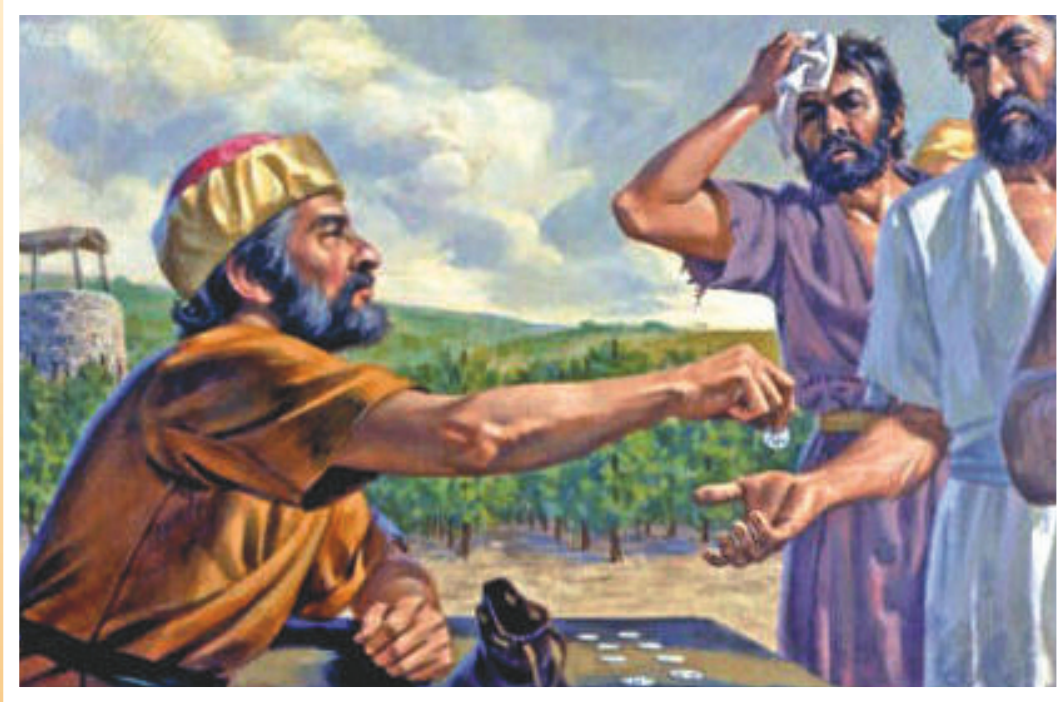


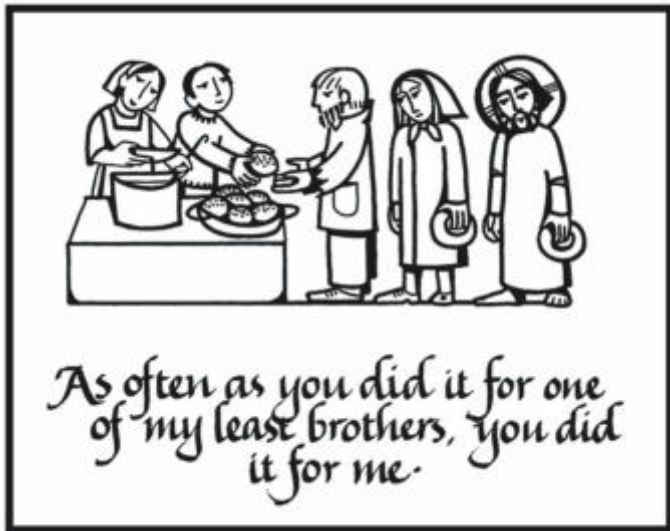

## From the Pastor's Desk . . .

**To feed the hungry** I am always touched by the parishioners who bring food to Church and quietly place it at the doors. I often see you. You are performing a holy work of mercy. Those who bring the food here, those who collect it from here and the stores that donate it to us, those who deliver it to soup kitchens and homeless shelters... you make me feel very proud and thankful. I know what you do. I watch you do it.



As a human, as a priest, and as someone very much involved with Catholic Charities, I thank you! God will embrace you for these simple but lifesaving works! You are all doing the work of angels to the glory of God. It is a work of mercy, an act of love for humanity, an expression of the dignity of the human person. And it is almost always done quietly, even anonymously, like the best works of charity. Only God may know.

**The saints** As you know, we are restoring the painted statues on our property. Our parishioner and resident artist, Nicole Lioi, has finished three as I write this: St. Jude on the south side of the Church, St. Pio behind the Church and St. Therese of Liseiux in front of the rectory. Nicole is also working at home on the Blessed Virgin Mary from behind the rectory. We also want to restore the most damaged of all statues, St. Francis of Assisi, which stands on the large rock on the walkway from the parking lot. After decades in the scorching sun, the brown habit of Francis is virtually white. In order to restore this statue, Nicole needed it to be removed from the stone and brought to her own studio. St. Francis is solid concrete, and was cemented to the stone, and there was a metal pipe embedded in the stone that made it difficult to remove the statue. I asked a professional contractor to attempt it. He did so and after two men chiseled and then used an electric saw, we freed Francis from the stone! The problem is... his head fell off.

As I think about it, this is perfect. I will fix his head and return it to his shoulders. We all lose our heads from time to time. In his case some Crazy Glue can fix it. With that and a new paint job and protective sealant, St. Francis will look perfectly new again! We will return him to his rock and no one but us need know that his head is attached by glue.



This restoration project is fun and it beautifies the property while honoring the saints! We are not done yet. I am very thankful to Nicole who is gifted with extraordinary artistic skills!

**Aquinas** I am happy to tell you that Aquinas Academy is off and running. We have had a very good start to the new academic year. What I noticed first was the pure joy so many of our children showed upon returning to Aquinas, or coming here for the first time. Several students have transferred in from the public schools, due to our excellent school and the fact that we have in-person classes. We all have much of which to be proud in Aquinas. Even if you and your children have gone to school elsewhere, please keep Aquinas in your awareness.

**Returning** Have you noticed that every week the number of the faithful at Mass grows a little? The dispensation from the Mass obligation remains in effect, so if you have a reasonable health concern about being present during this pandemic time, the Mass obligation is lifted. But it is nice to see more people present. I am especially thankful to you for supporting your parish through these most unusual times. Remember the Missions too! The Propagation of the Faith, like every charity, has taken a major hit during the pandemic months.

And we are always grateful to our sanitizing team! After each Sunday Mass and during the week the Church surfaces, doors, handles, light switches, microphones, and anything else we can think of, is sanitized!

Remember to not get complacent with regard to the virus. Keep your guard up, with common sense use of hand sanitizer, soap, wipes, and the rest.

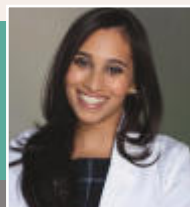

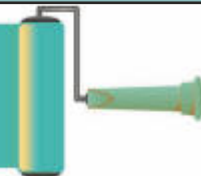
